



# LAUNDRY SHEETS

## DESCRIPTION

The goal is to install plastic-free dispensers to distribute detergent sheets to students. This would address hygiene insecurity and reduce waste.

## NEED

Not only would this aid lower-income students in covering hygiene costs, it would also reduce overall waste.

**COST** \$300



## OUTCOME

This will provide 1 year of laundry detergent for 30 students, by helping to fund \$10,000 dollars needed to install 2 Generation Conscious laundry detergent machines.

## SOLUTION

Installing a closed-loop Generation Conscious system where students can pick up the detergent sheets that are paid for by the school. The overall fundraising goal is \$10,000 and this would cover 2 laundry detergent machines and 30,000 laundry sheets. This would provide 600-1,000 students with detergent for a year. The annual restocking cost of \$4000 per machine will be covered by \$5 increase to the student fee.

## IMPLEMENTATION

Zero Waste Hygiene Equity Program (ASG) will implement this program. Specifically, the program heads Elise Neal and Melanie Tapia will be responsible for this project.

## OUR RESEARCH

According to Generation Conscious's research, every detergent sheet dispensed will result in a saving of 0.14 kg CO2 compared to pod detergents. Additionally, students would save money on detergent.
